

## Did you know?



Over **15,000** people have abseiled the Spinnaker Tower since the opportunity first arose in 2011 - which is more than the distance between the Earth and the International Space Station, and back!

The CONCRETE used to create the Tower would fill five and a half Olympic sized swimming pools.

The bows are formed from **1200 TONNES** of structural steel, which is the equivalent of 12 BLUE WHALES.

The design was chosen by the **PEOPLE OF PORTSMOUTH.** 

There are **587 STEPS** from the base to the Sky Garden at the top of the Spinnaker Tower.

The spinnaker tower is visible from an aircraft flying at **30,000 feet.** 

The tower is founded on 84 piles, the longest of which runs **50m** into the ground, the equivalent of Nelson's Column.

Portsmouth was a small town up until the 1500s when **Henry VIII** built the world's earliest known dry dock in Portsmouth Dockyard.

The Spinnaker Tower has had over **3 MILLION VISITORS** since opening in 2005.

In high winds, the Tower can 'sway' up to 150mm.
